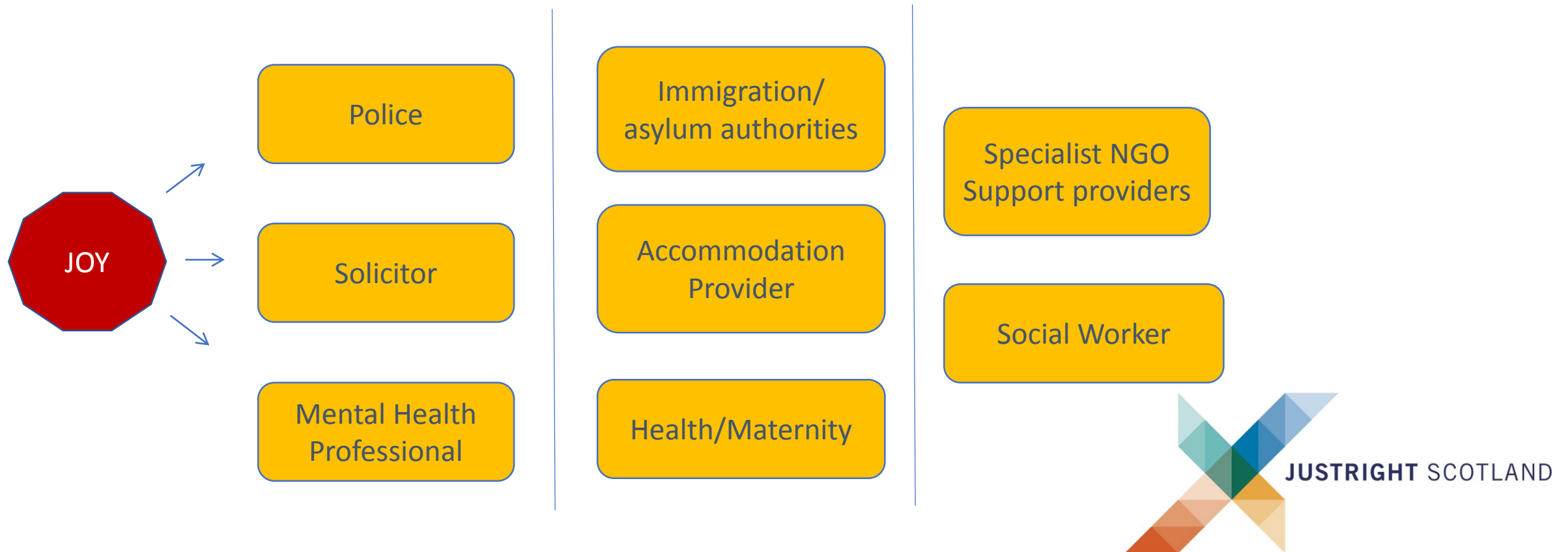

JustRight Scotland/EU Assist JOY

- Female Pregnant Survivor of Trafficking for Sexual Exploitation from Nigeria
- She has children who remain in Nigeria.
- Ongoing criminal investigation and pre birth child protection assessments
- Recognised as a victim of human trafficking under the identification system called an NRM and been given a short term residence permit for her health needs.
- She fears return to Nigeria.
- She is living with a friend as she does not wish to move into the temporary accommodation that has been offered to her as it is not suitable due to her health/fears.
